Empowering working artists to see their vision through an entrepreneurial lens.

Nashville's community of artists and makers is growing at a rapid pace. As more artists shift away from traditional day-jobs into creative enterprises, they face new challenges that come with running a small business. The success of these arts businesses is critical to the growth of Nashville's creative economy.

The Arts & Business Council has an eight-year track record of teaching Nashville's arts community effective techniques to bolster business and expand the arts through seminars (1,300+ attendees) and sold-out in intensive trainings. In 2014, the Arts & Business Council partnered with these key organizations to launch Periscope, which provides comprehensive small-business training, geared at Nashville's creative community:





GOALS OF PERISCOPE

- Training: 8 weeks of professional development training for working artists
- Exchange: Artists share best practices with interdisciplinary peers through small group work
- Mentorship: Each artist is paired one-on-one with a high-caliber business mentor
- **Exposure:** Year-round opportunities to celebrate the work of alumni artists, plus red-letter visibility at the culminating celebration, the Periscope Pitch Event in Fall 2018.

SNAPSHOT OF THE PROGRAM

- Who: 20 artists, artisans, and makers of all disciplines including visual artists, fashion designers, filmmakers, authors, choreographers, craft artists, playwrights, and more
- What: Half-day sessions once a week for 8 weeks
- When: May-July 2018, with the culminating Pitch event in September
- Where: The Nashville Entrepreneur Center

IMPACT OF PERISCOPE
